

To whom it may concern,

The **Anglican Diocese of Sydney** is an approved SRE provider in NSW and is committed to providing quality SRE where students have the opportunity to learn and grow in their understanding of the Christian faith and its implications for life.

SRE teachers representing the Anglican Diocese of Sydney are authorised by the local Rector and are fully accredited to teach SRE in your school.

In order to attain Accreditation each SRE teacher must fulfil the following requirements:

- **SRE Theory and Practice** – complete four training modules, each of two hours duration.
 - Understanding the context of SRE (schools, legislation)
 - Understanding the developing child/adolescent
 - Preparing and delivering a lesson
 - Group management
- **Bible Foundations** – complete one training module of two hours duration.
- **SRE Development training** – attend a minimum of two hours development training each year.
- **Teaching observation** – be observed teaching one class per year.
- **Safe Ministry Training** – participate in an initial four and a half hour training on the three components of safe ministry: good leadership, safe practices, and safe environments. Complete a two and a half hour refresher every three years after initial training.
- **Have their Working with Children Check number verified by their local church.**
- **Be given authorisation from the senior minister of their church.**
